The First Meeting in 2023-24 of the Senate Committee on Sub-degree, Professional and Continuing Education Programmes (Senate Committee on SPCEP) was held on 28 September 2023. Major items dealt with at that meeting were as follows:

The revised template on Proposal for Introduction of New Self-financed Sub-degree, Professional and Continuing Education Programme (SPCEP) was noted.

The initial analysis of the ratings in the review panels' reports of 24 programmes was noted.

The Quality Assurance (QA) Compensations from 1 July 2022 to 30 June 2023 were endorsed.

The proposal for formulating a re-approval mechanism for programmes at Hong Kong Qualifications Framework 1-3 or equivalent was considered.

The proposed guidelines on Virtual Teaching and Learning (VTL) courses in SPCEPs were approved.

The statistical summaries and biennial report on the distribution of merits and distinctions for Professional and Continuing Education (PCE) programmes for the period of 1 January 2021 – 31 December 2022 were considered while the upcoming enhancement of the biennial reports was noted.

The annual report on the distribution of merits and distinctions for Higher Diploma (HD) programmes for the period of 1 January 2022 – 31 December 2022 was considered.

The biennial report on data collected from the Non-CUSIS Class Information Database (CID) from 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2023 was noted.

The annual report 2022-23 of the Senate Committee on SPCEP was approved.
